



## DESMOND TUTU STUDY AND CARE FUND

The International Children's Peace Prize is awarded annually to a child who fights courageously for children's rights. The International Children's Peace Prize is the most prestigious prize that a young changemaker can receive in recognition of their efforts to move the world. It gives the young winner a worldwide platform to amplify their message and promote causes for the benefit of children's rights. This year the message of the 15-year-old winner Bana Alabed, reached billions of people worldwide. Each winner is entitled to a study and care grant from the Desmond Tutu Study and Care Fund to enable them to access education and to support their siblings and family where needed.

**The Desmond Tutu Study and Care Fund is divided into the following two components:**

**STUDY COMPONENT:** The winner of the International Children's Peace Prize receives support (scholarship) from KidsRights in obtaining an education, at least until bachelor level (BA) with also a possibility to apply for funding for a master's degree. The goal is to provide an opportunity to the young winner to develop themselves as much as possible, and to prepare for a successful future.

**CARE COMPONENT:** The care component is made available to ensure the wellbeing of the winner and their family. The winner can receive the care fund to support the education of their siblings so they are not left out, to start an income-generating project for the family, or to cover their own healthcare expenses.
