The world's leading youth prize

- Organise the annual International Children's Peace Prize ceremony in capitals around the world to expand our reach and increase our impact on Children's Rights.
- Strategically support the activities of youth and youth-led organisations on children's rights issues relating to the winners' work.
- Amplify the message of the winner and the finalists to fuel systemic changes for advancing the rights of children, nationally and internationally.

RESEARCH



The world's leading independent international institute and "watchdog" on children's rights

- Build on the authority of the KidsRights Index by integrating a climate change domain to develop a climate-conscious KidsRights Index.
- Engage with governments, intergovernmental organisations, and companies to actively advise on advancing the rights of children.
- Launch an interactive web platform to disseminate the findings of the KidsRights Index.
- Co-create a child-friendly KidsRights Index to inform and encourage children to advocate for their rights.

ACTION



The world's first borderless digital "state" that amplifies and connects youth voices and youth actions globally

- *State of Youth International*: Strengthen the central role of the State of Youth chapters, optimize and expand partnerships, and pilot a new grantmaking model.
- *State of Youth NL*: Collaborate with more organisations, become the go-to representative panel of Dutch youth (12-29) to for shared goals; As a representative panel of dutch youth (12-29)
- *State of Youth Kids*: Teach children (6-12) about child rights and SDG's in a fun, playful way. Establish partnerships with schools to empower more children to become future changemakers.
