

# WHAT IS THE KIDSRIGHTS INDEX



The KidsRights Index measures how well countries are upholding children's rights, including on life, health, education, protection, and enabling environment. It helps us understand where children are thriving and where improvements are needed.

## HOW TO READ THE INDEX:



### 1. Rankings and Scores:

Understand where countries stand.



### 2. Indicators:

Identify specific areas for improvement (e.g. education and health).



### 3. Trends:

Notice if your country is improving or needs more help.

## HOW YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE:



### 1. RAISE AWARENESS

- **Talk about it:** Discuss with friends, family, teachers and community members.
- **Share information:** Share findings from the KidsRights Index on social media.



### 2. ADVOCATE FOR CHANGE

- **Write Letters:** Write to local government officials about issues in your community.
- **Movements:** Join or form youth groups to fight for children's rights.



### 3. START A PROJECT

- **School Projects:** Start a project in your school to improve children's rights.
- **Community Involvement:** Organise community events like clean-up drives or health camps.
